

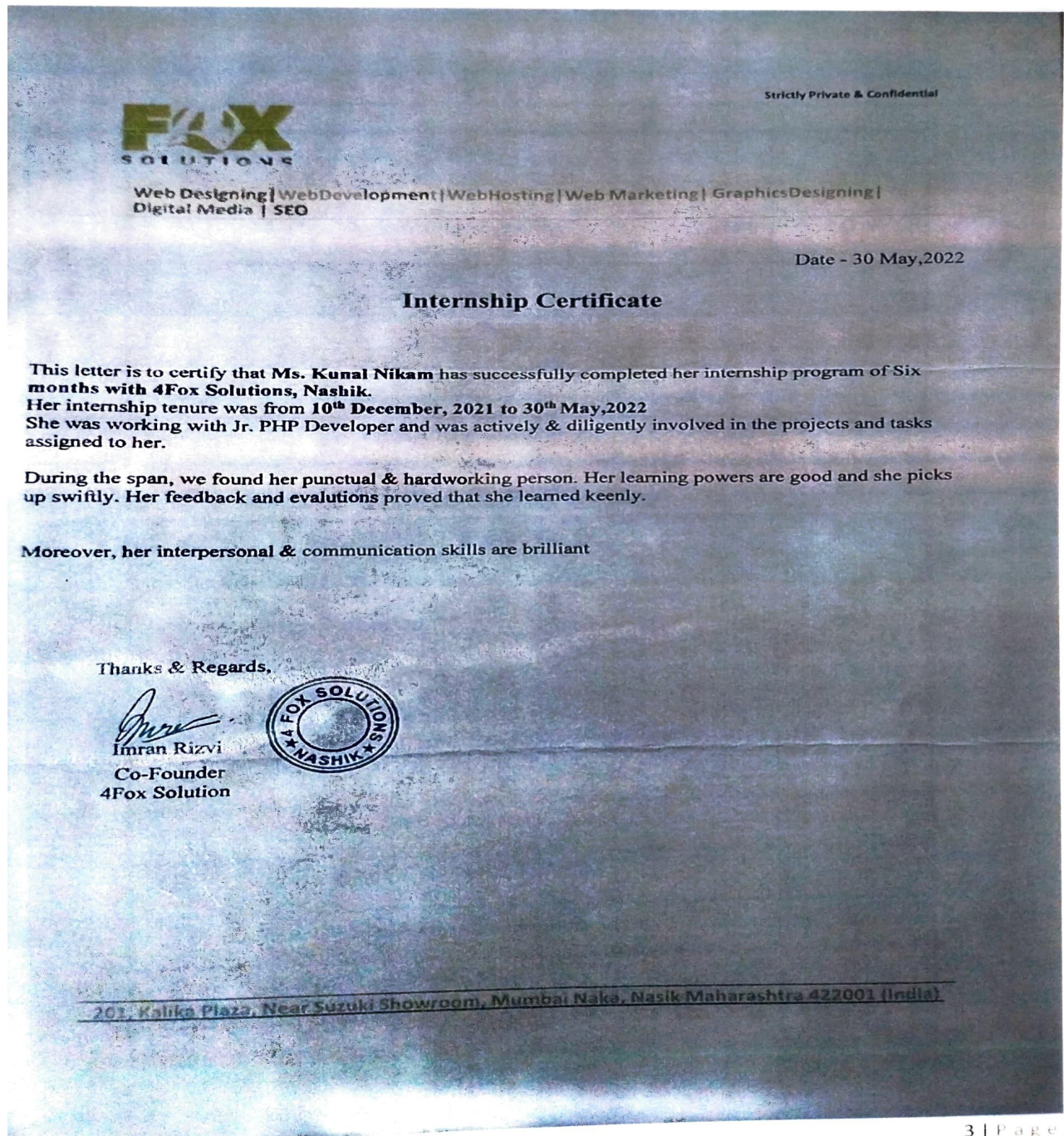

1. Introduction

❖ Organization/Company Profile –

❖ Institute Profile – Department of Comp. Science

The Computer Science Department of MGV'S Panchavati College of Management and computer science Nashik was established in 2001-02. It is the foundation and renowned department offering Computer Science and Computer Application Education under Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The aim of the department is to prepare students to enter into the world of technology. The Department of Computer Science offers a 3-year undergraduate course B.Sc. (Computer Science) with an intake capacity of 160 seats, M.Sc (Computer Science) with an intake capacity of 30 seats and BBA(CA) (Computer Application) with an intake capacity of 80 for each class. Objectives of Cooperation

- B. The Parties wish to co-operate with each other as per the terms and conditions enumerated in this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES SET FORTH THEIR PRELIMINARY UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:

1. Scope

1.1 The scope of this MoU is to provide a framework of reference to build a strong and on-going relationship between **parties** in various areas of mutual interest and benefit by ESEP.

2 Objectives

- e. All the exchange program activities should be planned keeping in mind the academic calender & it should not disturb the flow of academic activities.

Participating College jointly agree:

- b. There shall be no monetary consideration in any activities conducted.
- c. Conveyance for transportation is discretionary at the option of parties.

6. Terms and Termination

- a. This shall come in to effect from , 15/07/2018 and shall remain in effect for a period of twelve (12) months, unless terminated earlier by the Parties. On mutual agreement after a period of twelve months, MOU can be further extended.
- b. Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MOU by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other Party.

7. Confidentiality

11.3. The Parties agree shall mutually endeavor to appoint a single arbitrator from ACBCS, within a period of thirty (30) days. The appointed arbitrator will be referred for resolution. The arbitration proceedings will held at Nashik and only Nashik court will have Jurisdiction to resolve the matter.

11. Governing Law and Jurisdiction.

12.1 This MOU shall be governed by the laws of Republic of India. Any dispute arising in connection therewith shall be submitted only to Nashik, India court have Jurisdiction to resolve the matter.


