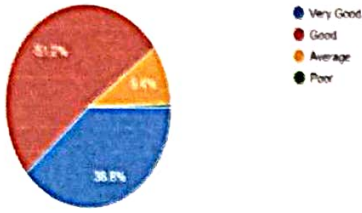

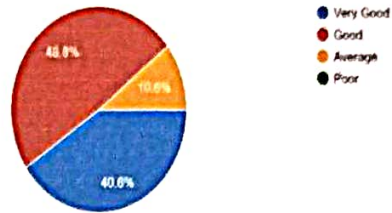


Graphical representation of Analysis Report (2023-24) :

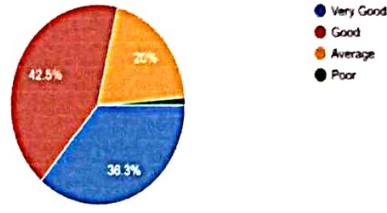

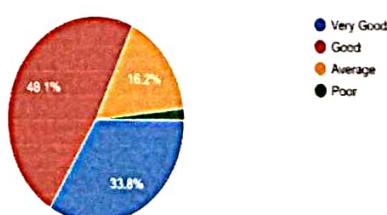

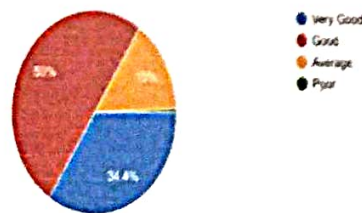
